S:0318:02 <i>Questions from the public</i>	There were no questions from the public.
S:0318:03 <i>Declarations of interest</i>	Cllr S Birnstingl declared an interest in item S:0318:08 in his capacity as a regular paying user of the sports hall.
S:0318:04 <i>Minutes of previous meeting</i>	The minutes of the meeting dated 23 rd January 2018 were approved by all present and signed by the Chairman. <i>Proposed by T Kardos; Seconded by P Kentell.</i>

The Clerk noted that this would take up most or all of the unallocated project funds in the budget, and it was therefore agreed that this should be considered by the full council at its June meeting.
